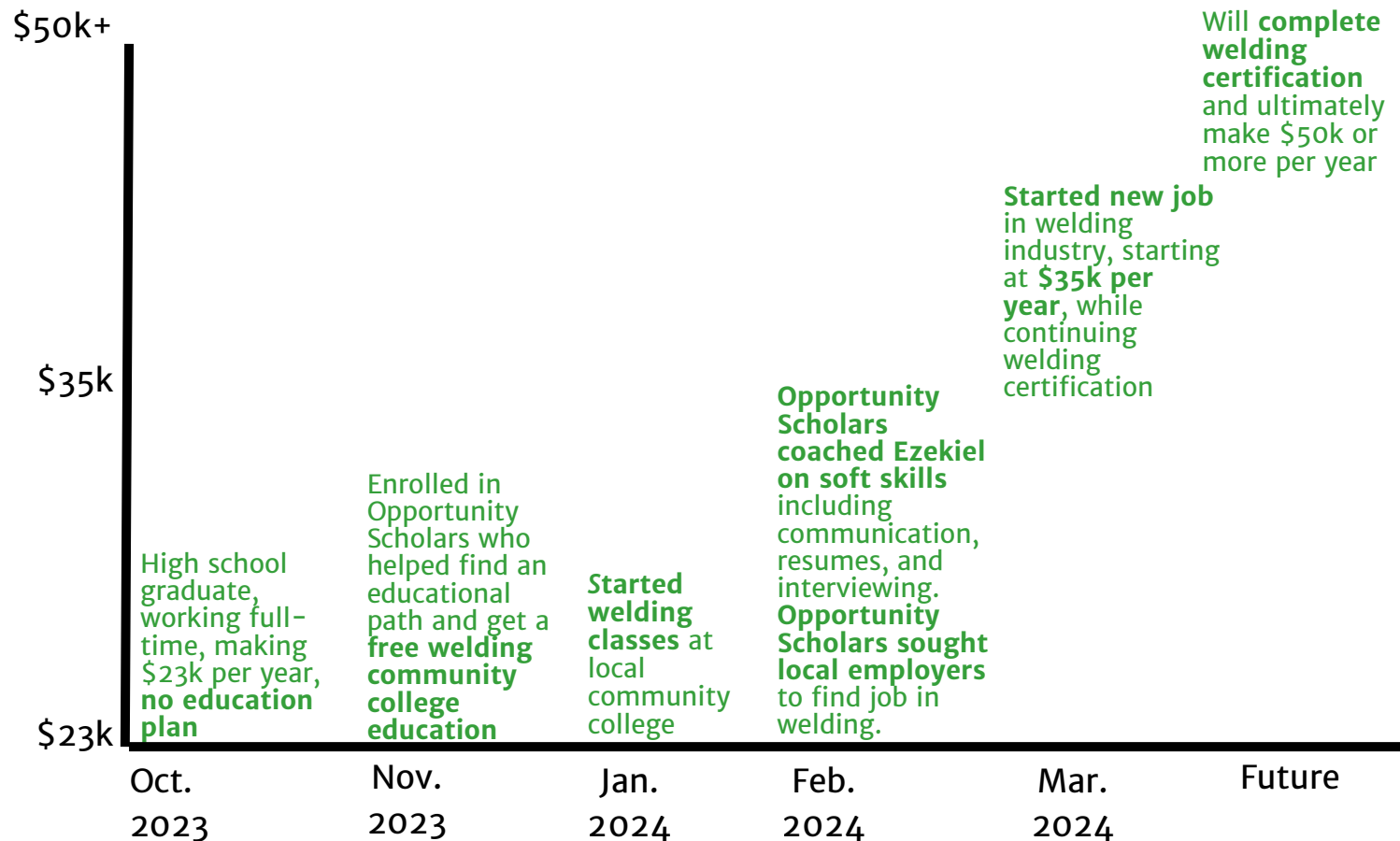
Why should other people join Opportunity Scholars?

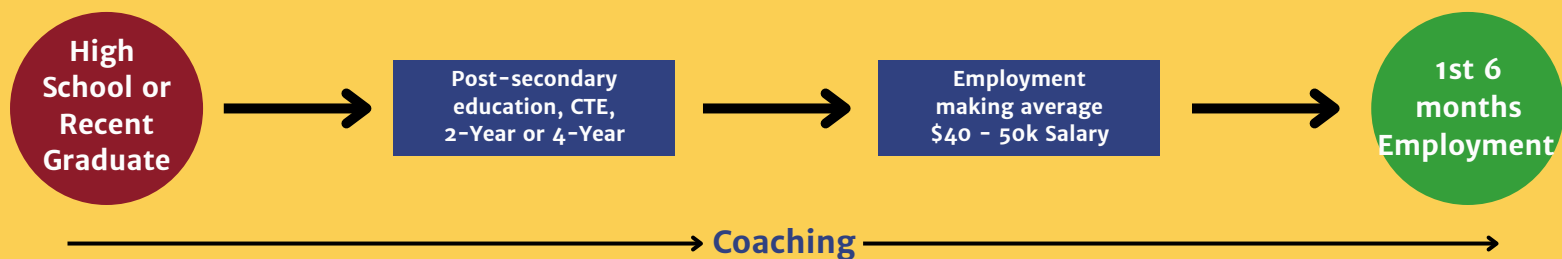

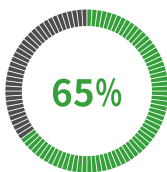
- Numerous high school graduates face uncertainty about their next steps. Opportunity Scholars provides crucial guidance and support in navigating these pivotal decisions.

Opportunity Scholars Process

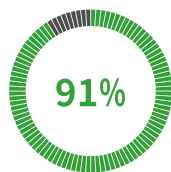


Enrolled Student Demographics

Female



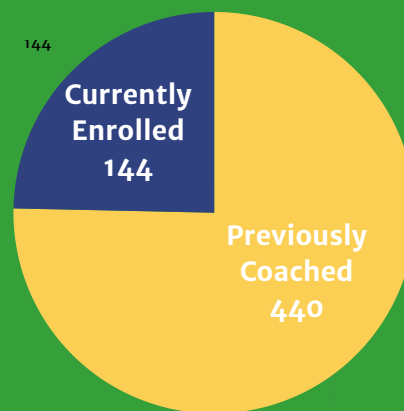
