# Why should other people join Opportunity Scholars?





- Virginia faces a shortage of skilled trades workers. Opportunity Scholars is poised to address

  careers in the trades sector.
- Projected Virginia Registered Nursing Shortages through 2030 is 26.2%. Opportunity Scholars is positioned to to make an impact in this shortage by supporting aspiring nurses.
